NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL.

The Chairman of the Security Council Commission of Investigation established under resolution 571 (1985) to evaluate the damage resulting from the invasion of Angola by South African forces and to report to the Council not later than 15 November 1985 has informed the President that the Commission is still in the process of finalizing its report to the Council, called for in paragraph 7 of resolution 571 (1985), and requires one week to complete its task. The Commission has, accordingly, requested an extension of the deadline for submission of its report to the Council by one week, that is, until 22 November 1985.

Following informal consultations on the matter, it has been found that no member of the Security Council has any objection to the Commission's request and the Chairman of the Commission has been so informed.
