PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1990-1991

The contingency fund: consolidated statement of programme  
budget implications and revised estimates

Report of the Secretary-General

1. The level of the contingency fund for the biennium 1990-1991 was set at \$15,000,000 by the General Assembly in its resolution 43/214. As noted by the Assembly in its resolution 44/201 A, section IX, a balance of \$13,120,500 remains in the contingency fund following the initial appropriations approved by the Assembly at its forty-fourth session.
2. The consolidated statement of programme budget implications and revised estimates falling under the guidelines for the contingency fund contained in the annex to General Assembly resolution 42/211 is submitted in the annex to the present document. The amounts contained in respect of each item correspond to those previously recommended by the Fifth Committee during the current session upon consideration of individual statements and proposals for revised estimates.
3. The consolidated amount of \$9,901,800 is within the available balance of the contingency fund. It is therefore proposed that the Fifth Committee, in accordance with section A, paragraph 5, of the annex to General Assembly resolution 42/211, should proceed to recommend the appropriation of the required amount under the relevant sections of the programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991, as follows:
