Situation of human rights in southern Lebanon

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The present note is submitted in accordance with paragraph 5 of resolution 1990/54 of 6 March 1990 of the Commission on Human Rights on the situation of human rights in southern Lebanon.

As indicated in General Assembly document A/45/578, the Secretary-General, in accordance with the request contained in paragraph 5 of the above-mentioned resolution, addressed on 14 June 1990 a note verbale to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the State of Israel, in which he drew the attention of the Minister for Foreign Affairs to paragraph 5 of the resolution.
