1. At its 42nd meeting, on 10 December 1990, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/45/60) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution VIII recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 109 of its report (A/45/838). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/45/SR.42).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution VIII recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 109 of its report (A/45/838), no additional appropriations would be required in 1990-1991. Additional provisions for 1992-1993 would be included in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993.
