- 1. At its 42nd meeting, on 10 December 1990, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/45/60) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution VIII recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 109 of its report (A/45/838). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution VIII recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 109 of its report (A/45/838), no additional appropriations would be required in 1990-1991. Additional provisions for 1992-1993 would be included in the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993.
