## Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 42nd meeting, on 10 December 1990, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/45/59) on the programme budget implications of draft resolutions I, II, IV, VI, IX-XIII and XV recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 51 of its report (A/45/756). The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/45/SR.42).

## DECISION OF THE FIITH COMMITTEE

- 3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions I, II, IV, VI, IX-XIII and XV recommended by the Third Committee in paragraph 51 of its report (A/45/756):
- (a) Additional requirements of \$364,900 would arise under section 8, Activities on global social development issues, of the programme budget for the

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biennium 1990-1991. Moreover, an amount of \$35,000 would be required under section 31, Staff assessment, to be offset by a corresponding amount under income section 1, Income from staff assessment;

(b) Such requirements would constitute an additional expenditure derived from legislative mandates not provided for in the programme budget for the biennium 1990-1991 and would therefore be subject to the guidelines for the use of the contingency fund approved by the General Assembly in its resolution 42/211 of 21 December 1987. The actual additional requirements would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of all programme budget implications and revised estimates to be submitted towards the end of the current session, in accordance with the provisions of section C, paragraphs 5 and 6, of the annex to resolution 42/211.

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
