Representative of Argentina to the United Nations
addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that on 27 January 1991, the Argentine Government sent a Boeing 707 aircraft to Pisa, Italy, to cooperate in the Gulf emergency plan of the Office of the United Nations Disaster Relief Coordinator (UNDRO).

The aircraft will operate under the United Nations emblem, shipping foodstuffs, medicines, surgical supplies and other non-military equipment to meet the basic needs of persons displaced as a result of the war in the region.

I should be grateful if you would have the text of this letter distributed as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 35 and 153, and of the Security Council.
