Statement of 28 September 1985 by the Honourable Chamber of Senators of the Nation of the Argentine Republic

"The Senate of the Nation

"States:

- "1. That it supports the commemoration of the fortieth anniversary of the founding of the United Nations, established by the international community at the San Francisco Conference on 24 October 1945;
- "2. That it likewise expresses the hope that the action of the United Nations on behalf of justice, peace and development of all peoples will continue to serve as a foundation and guideline for all the nations of the world;
- "3. That it also hopes that all Member States will contribute, with profound ethical feeling and firm political will, to the present and future strengthening of the world Organization."
