

STATUS OF THE INTERNATIONAL COVENANTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Report by the Secretary-General

- 1. At its thirty-fifth session, the Commission on Human Rights had before it a note by the Secretary-General (E/CN.4/1329) on the status of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.
- By its resolution 6 (XXXV) of 2 March 1979, the Commission reaffirmed the importance of the International Covenants on Human Rights as major parts of international efforts to promote universal respect for and observance of human rights and fundamental freedoms; again invited all States which had not yet done so to become parties to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights as well as to consider acceding to the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights; invited the States parties to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights to consider making the declaration provided for in article 41 of that Covenant; and requested the Secretary-General to submit to the Commission on Human Rights at its thirty-sixth session a report on the status of the International Covenants on Human Rights and on the Optional Protocol and to include in this report information on the work of the Economic and Social Council and its Working Group on the implementation of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights. The present note was prepared in response to that request.
- 3. Since the adoption by the Commission of resolution 6 (XXXV), the two Covenants were ratified or acceded to by El Salvador, the Gambia, Iceland, India, Japan and Morocco. As a result, on 31 December 1979, 63 States had become parties to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights and 61 States had become parties to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights. The list of States that had signed, ratified or acceded to the Covenants, as well as the dates of their signature, ratification or accession, may be found in annexes I and II. Also indicated in annex II are the 12 States parties which have so far made the declaration under article 41 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, recognizing the competence of the Human Rights Committee to receive and consider communications to the effect that a State party claims that another State party is not fulfilling its obligations under the Covenant. The provisions of article 41 entered into force on 28 March 1979 in accordance with paragraph 2 of that article.

- 4. In addition, the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights was acceded to by Iceland. As of 31 December 1979, 22 States parties to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights had also become parties to the Protocol. The list of States that had signed, ratified or acceded to the Protocol, as well as the dates of their signature, ratification or accession, may be found in annex III.
- 5. As regards the implementation of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, the Sessional Working Group on the Implementation of that Covenant, established in accordance with Economic and Social Council decision 1978/10 of 3 Nay 1978, held its first session at United Nations Headquarters from 17 April to 3 May 1979. At the first meeting, Mr. Klaus Törnudd (Finland) was elected Chairman of the Working Group by acclamation.
- 6. The Working Group decided to devote its first session to organizational matters, especially the formulation of its methods of work as requested in Economic and Social Council decision 1978/10 and made recommendations on the subject in its report (E/1979/64) to the Council at its first regular session, 1979. By its resolution 1979/43 of 11 May 1979 entitled "Implementation of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights", the Council approved the methods of work recommended by its Working Group. Copies of Council resolution 1979/43 which includes the methods of work of the Sessional Working Group will be available to the Commission at its thirty-sixth session.
- 7. At the first regular session of the Council to be held in 1980, the Sessional Working Group will undertake the examination of reports (E/1978/8 and Add.1 to 27) submitted by States parties under the first stage of the programme established by Council resolution 1988 (LX), concerning rights covered by articles 6 to 9 of the Covenant.
- 8. The General Assembly in its resolution 34/45 of 23 November 1979 welcomed the information that the Economic and Social Council has now finalized arrangements for the consideration of reports submitted under the provisions of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, and expressed the hope that the Council will take steps to consider these reports as soon as possible.
- 9. As regards the implementation of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the Human Rights Committee held its sixth session at United Nations Headquarters from 9 to 27 April 1979, its seventh session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 30 July to 17 August 1979 and its eighth session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 15 to 26 October 1979. During these three sessions the Committee considered reports submitted by 12 States parties under article 40 of the Covenant, and concluded consideration of 2 communications, by adopting its views on the merits of these cases, under article 5 (4) of the Optional Protocol.
- 10. The third annual report of the Human Rights Committee 1/ covering the activities of the Committee at its sixth and seventh sessions was adopted at the conclusion of its seventh session on 17 August 1979. The report was submitted through the Economic and Social Council to the General Assembly at its thirty-fourth session. Following the decision of the Human Rights Committee at its fifth session to adopt its annual reports at the end of its summer sessions for appropriate transmission to the General Assembly through the Council in compliance with the requirement of article 45 of the Covenant, the activities of the Committee at its October session will be covered in its next annual report.

- In its resolution 34/45 of 23 November 1979, the General Assembly noted with appreciation the report of the Human Rights Committee on its sixth and seventh sessions and expressed satisfaction at the serious and constructive manner in which the Committee is continuing to undertake its functions, as well as at the co-operation extended to the Committee by the States parties which have submitted their reports under article 40 of the Covenant. The Assembly urged States parties which have not yet done so to submit their reports to the Committee as speedily as possible; requested the Secretary-General to continue to keep the Human Rights Committee informed of the activities of the Commission on Human Rights, the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities and the Committee on the Elimination of Racial Discrimination and also to transmit the annual reports of the Human Rights Committee to these bodies; and requested further the Secretary-General, in preparing the report mentioned in decision 23 (XXXV) of the Commission on Human Rights concerning the development of public information activities in the field of human rights, to bear in mind the question of improving the publicity for the work of the Human Rights Committee.
- 12. The Human Rights Committee is scheduled to hold its ninth session from 17 March to 3 April 1980 at the United Nations Office at Geneva. In its resolution 34/45, the General Assembly noted with due attention the recommendation of the Human Rights Committee regarding the holding of future meetings of the Committee in developing countries and requested the Secretary-General to explore this possibility, taking into account the Committee's recommendation and to submit a report in this regard to the Assembly at its thirty-fifth session.
