## Declaration on Nicaragua issued on 26 February 1991 by the 12 States members of the European Community

On the occasion of the first anniversary of the elections that made possible, in a democratic fashion, a change of government in Nicaragua, the European Community and its member States reiterate their support for pluralist democracy in that country and throughout Central America.

They express their conviction that the Central American countries will continue to display their determination to attain fully the objectives of the regional peace process through national reconciliation and the respect and promotion of human rights.
