Declaration on the Gulf crisis issued on 24 February 1991 by the 12 States members of the European Community

The Community and its member States deeply regret that Iraq has failed to respond positively to the appeal of the international coalition to withdraw immediately and unconditionally from Kuwait in accordance with the United Nations Security Council resolutions. In this grave moment, the Community and its member States are at the side of the forces of the allied coalition.

The Community and its member States hope that the liberation of Kuwait can now intervene rapidly and with a minimum of loss in human lives on both sides.
