Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/22110 of 28 January 1991 and S/22110/Add.3 of 1 February 1991.

During the week ending 23 February 1991, the Security Council took action on the following item:

The situation between Iraq and Kuwait (see S/21100/Add.30, S/21100/Add.31, S/21100/Add.32, S/21100/Add.33, S/21100/Add.36, S/21100/Add.37, S/21100/Add.38, S/21100/Add.42, S/21100/Add.43, S/21100/Add.47 and S/22110/Add.6)

In accordance with the decision taken by the Council at its 2977th (Part I) meeting on 13 February 1991 (see S/22110/Add.6), on 23 February 1991, the second and closed part of the 2977th meeting of the Security Council was resumed for the third time [S/PV.2977 (Part II) (closed-resumption 3)] to continue consideration of the item, following which the meeting was suspended.
