IDENTICAL LETTERS DATED 18 MARCH 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED RESPECTIVELY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you of the situation set forth below in the matter of Kuwaiti aircraft:

- I. Seven aircraft destroyed as a result of aerial bombardment by the Allied Forces, as follows:
 - 2 Airbus 300 aircraft;
 - 2 Boeing 767 aircraft;
 - 1 125 aircraft:
 - 2 G-3 aircraft.
- II. 8 existing aircraft, as follows:
 - 1 Airbus 300 aircraft in Iran;
 - 5 Airbus 310 aircraft in Iran;
 - 1 Boeing 727 aircraft in Oman;
 - 1 125 aircraft in Iraq.
- I request you to have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
