NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At the 104th plenary meeting of its thirty-fourth session, on 14 December 1979, the General Assembly adopted resolution 34/128, entitled "Assistance to Zambia".* In paragraph 12 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"Requests the Security Council to examine the situation in Zambia, in the context of Chapter VII, Articles 49 and 50, of the Charter of the United Nations, with a view to proposing additional measures of assistance to Zambia in view of its critical economic and financial position."
