Programme budget implications of the draft decision recommended
by the Second Committee (A/40/1042, para. 18)

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Falk MELTKE (German Democratic Republic)

1. At its 65th meeting, on 14 December 1985, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/40/94) on the programme budget implications of the draft decision recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 18 of its report (A/40/1042). The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/40/SR.65).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 63 to 15, with 11 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft decision recommended by the Second Committee in paragraph 18 of its report (A/40/1042), an additional appropriation of \$600,000 would be required under section 33 (Grant to the United Nations Institute for Training and Research) of the programme budget for the biennium 1986-1987.

4. The voting was as follows:

Against: Australia, Belgium, Bulgaria, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Canada, Czechoslovakia, German Democratic Republic, Hungary, Japan, Mongolia, Poland, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America.
