Appointment of a member of the Intergovernmental Working Group
on a Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Programme

Note by the Secretary-General

1. Further to his communication dated 11 March 1991 (see A/45/973, para. 2), the President of the General Assembly informed the Secretary-General on 15 March 1991 that, having concluded his consultations with the Chairman of the Group of African States, he had appointed Ghana with immediate effect as a member of the Intergovernmental Working Group on a Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Programme.
2. The Intergovernmental Working Group on a Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Programme is thus composed of the following 29 members: Argentina, Australia, Burkina Faso, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Egypt, France, Germany, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Japan, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Malaysia, Malawi, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Philippines, Poland, Sudan, Sweden, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America and Yugoslavia.
