IDENTICAL LETTERS DATED 21 MARCH 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
RESPECTIVELY TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL AND THE PRESIDENT
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to the letter dated 5 March 1991 from Mr. Tariq Aziz, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs, addressed to you, on instructions from my Government I have the honour to transmit to you herewith a list, in the Arabic and English languages, indicating in detail the standard gold coins, banknotes, monetary coins and other coins belonging to Kuwait which are in the possession of Iraq, and to assure you that we are ready to return them immediately in such manner as may be determined by the Security Council.

I should be grateful if you would kindly have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
