Letter dated 5 April 1991 from the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of Kuwait addressed to the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 4 April 1991, in which Kuwait welcomed the adoption by the Security Council of resolution 687 (1991), and with a view to facilitating your mission with regard to the demarcation of the boundary between Iraq and Kuwait, I have the honour to inform you that Kuwait confirms its approval of the sheets in the K7611 Series of topographic maps of Kuwait on the scale 1:50,000 referred to in document S/22412. These maps indicate the official land and sea boundaries between Kuwait and the Republic of Iraq and served as a basis for, among other matters relating to bilateral relations, the signature of the "Agreed Minutes between the State of Kuwait and the Republic of Iraq" on 4 October 1963.

I should be grateful if you would have the text of this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
