LETTER DATED 2 APRIL 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ
TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government and further to my two letters dated 2 April 1991, I have the honour to inform you as follows:

- 1. On 1 and 2 April 1991, the United States and Saudi Arabian air activity was as follows: 62 sorties by 31 formations, 28 of which overflew Baghdad and 3 kilometre 160.
- 2. These operations were conducted at an altitude of between 3,000 and 7,000 metres and a speed of 750 kilometres per hour.
- 3. The aircraft in question were identified as being of the F-14, F-15 and F-16 types.
- 4. These operations filled the inhabitants observing the fast with uneasiness and anxiety.

I request you to have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
