LETTER DATED 1 APRIL 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ
TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government and further to my letter dated 31 March 1991, I have the honour to inform you as follows:

- 1. On 31 March 1991, the United States and Saudi Arabian air activity was as follows: 56 sorties at an altitude of between 3 and 8 kilometres and a speed of 720 kilometres per hour by 28 formations.
- 2. The air activity was concentrated over the city of Baghdad and its suburbs. The purpose was provocation, reconnaissance and observation, since the aircraft passed over Baghdad a number of times.

I request you to have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
