Report of the Secretary-General

Addendum

- 1. In its resolution 45/241 of 21 December 1990 entitled "United Nations common system: report of the International Civil Service Commission", the General Assembly approved a number of recommendations of the Commission that affect the Staff Regulations.
- 2. In section X of the resolution, the General Assembly approved the changes in the maximum admissible levels of expenses incurred under the education grant, as contained in paragraph 251 of the report of the Commission. $\underline{1}$ / However, this resolution did not contain the actual figures to be modified in regulation 3.2.
- 3. To reflect in the Staff Regulations the corresponding changes in maximum admissible expenses the following amendment is proposed: in regulation 3.2, lines 9 and 10, for \$9,000 read \$11,000 and for \$6,750 read \$8,250.
- 4. Section VIII of the sam: resolution and General Assembly resolution 45/251 of 21 December 1990 also contain amendments to the Staff Regulations on which the General Assembly has acted by approving the text of the consequential amendments. Other proposed texts of amendments to the Staff Regulations, as indicated in documents A/C.5/45/3 and Corr.1, are still pending consideration and approval by the Fifth Committee and the General Assembly.
- 5. The changes indicated above are being implemented through appropriate administrative issuances and amendments to the Staff Rules.
