Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 41st meeting, on 22 November 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/47) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions A/37/L.32 and A/37/L.33. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions were presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.41).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions A/37/L.32 and A/37/L.33, the related expenses would be met from within the resources already appropriated under section 3 A.2 of the programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983 and, therefore, no additional appropriations would be required.
