LETTER DATED 9 APRIL 1991 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to my report dated 5 April 1991 concerning proposed arrangements for the establishment of the United Nations Iraq/Kuwait Observation Mission (UNIKOM) (S/22454 and Add.1-3), which was approved by the Security Council in its resolution 689 (1991) of 9 April 1991. In paragraph 4 (a) of my report (S/22454), I stated that the command of UNIKOM would be exercised by a Chief Military Observer appointed by the Secretary-General with the consent of the Security Council.

I now wish to inform you that it is my intention, with the consent of the Council, to appoint Major-General Günther Greindl of Austria as Chief Military Observer of UNIKOM.

I should be grateful if you could bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
