COMMEMORATION OF THE FORTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Appointment of the members of the Group of High-level Intergovernmental Experts to Review the Efficiency of the Administrative and Financial Functioning of the United Nations

## Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. In paragraph 2 of resolution 40/237 of 18 December 1985, the General Assembly decided to establish a Group of High-level Intergovernmental Experts to Review the Efficiency of the Administrative and Financial Functioning of the United Nations. In paragraph 3 of the resolution, the Assembly requested the President of the Assembly, in consultation with the regional groups, to appoint as soon as possible the members of the Group of High-level Intergovernmental Experts with due regard to equitable geographical distribution. In paragraph 4 of the resolution, the Assembly decided that the Group would consist of 18 members.
- 2. On 3 February 1986, the President of the General Assembly informed the Secretary-General that, after consultation with the regional groups and with due regard to equitable geographical distribution, he had appointed the following persons as members of the Group of High-level Intergovernmental Experts:
