ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 19 February 1980 from the President of the Security Council to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly the following resolution (resolution 464 (1980)) on the admission of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 2198th meeting, on 19 February 1980:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines for admission to the United Nations, 1/

"Recommends to the General Assembly that Saint Vincent and the Grenadines be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim records of the 2197th and 2198th meetings of the Security Council, at which the application of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines was discussed.
