The Government of the Republic of Senegal has decided to withdraw the nomination of Mr. Doudou Thiam for a seat in the International Law Commission.

The spirit of understanding and the willingness to co-operate shown on the occasion of the elections, for the African region, of members of the International Law Commission were the reasons for this decision.

Senegal takes this opportunity to draw attention to the nomination of Mr. Kéba Mbaye, First President of the Supreme Court of Senegal, for a seat in the International Court of Justice.
