PROGRAMME BUDGET FOR THE BIENNIUM 1990-1991

Report of the Fifth Committee (Part II)

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 118 appear in the Committee's report (A/45/900 and Corr.1).
2. The Fifth Committee further considered the item at its 55th and 56th meetings, on 1 and 2 May 1991. It had before it the report of the Secretary-General on the conditions of service and compensation for officials other than Secretariat officials - members of the Joint Inspection Unit (A/C.5/45/75).
3. The comments and observations made in the course of the Committee's further consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/45/SR.55 and 56).

II. DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

4. At the 55th meeting, on 1 May 1991, on the proposal of the representative of the United States of America, the Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to recommend to the General Assembly that it defer to the forty-sixth session the consideration of the report of the Secretary-General on this matter (see para. 5).

III. RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

5. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly defer to the forty-sixth session consideration of the report of the Secretary-General on the conditions of service and compensation for officials other than Secretariat officials - members of the Joint Inspection Unit. 1/
