ANNEX

Statement on Ethiopia issued on 30 April 1991 by the European Community

The Community and its member States welcome the resolution adopted on 23 April 1991 by the Ethiopean Parliament, which, through its readiness to open peace negotiations with all opposition groups, especially through the establishment of a cease-fire, and to set up transitional arrangements guaranteeing a political solution acceptable to the whole of the Ethiopian population, has exemplified the will of Ethiopians to bring the civil war to an end peacefully and to seek a negotiated political settlement.

The Community and its member States renew their previous appeals and encourage all parties concerned to respond to these in a constructive way. They furthermore express the hope that the condicions necessary for the establishment of peace and stability can be rapidly achieved.

They reiterate their urgent appeal to all parties concerned to ensure that emergency humanitarian aid is in no way affected by the present conflict.
