Letter dated 11 April 1986 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Honduras addressed to the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Panama

I have the honour to write with reference to the invitation by the Contadora Group to the Central American Governments to pursue and bring to a conclusion the process of multilateral negotiation on peace and security in the region and to join together in signing the Contadora Act.

The Government of Honduras reaffirms its political will, recently expressed in its signing of the "Panama Undertaking", which reflects the agreement of 12 Latin American countries, to pursue and bring to a conclusion the negotiations and to join together, on the date specified in that document and in the final communiqué of the most recent meeting of Ministers for Foreign Affairs, in signing the Contadora Act on Peace and Co-operation in Central America.
