The Permanent Representative of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform that the Chargé d'affaires of the Pakistan Embassy at Kabul was summoned to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan at 10 a.m. on 9 March 1986 and the following was brought to his attention by the Director of the First Political Department:

"The Government of Pakistan, in continuation of its baseless and empty charges against the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan, has once again claimed that the frontier forces of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan have allegedly fired 15 shells on Shaman of Khyber Agency on 28 February 1986.

"The Government of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan, after thorough investigations, considers the Pakistani charges as void of reality and categorically rejects them. It is further mentioned that the Pakistani authorities should put an end to such insinuations which have no other result but further deterioration of the situation in the frontier areas."
