ANNEX

Statement issued by the Viet Nam News Agency on 2 April 1986
at Hanoi

According to foreign reports, on 28 March 1986, the Thai Ministry of Foreign Affairs sent a letter to the United Nations Secretary-General (A/41/253-S/17956) slanderously charging that Vietnamese troops had on many occasions intruded into, laid mines and fired artillery on Thai territory.

The Viet Nam News Agency is authorized to completely reject that fabrication.

This is only a shop-worn slander made by the Thai authorities to cover the gross violations by the Thai troops of the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the People's Republic of Kampuchea in support of the reactionary Khmer clique living along the Thai-Kampuchean border and to continue their criminal activities against the Kampuchean people.
