LETTER DATED 16 MAY 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF SAINT VINCENT AND THE GRENADINES TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to transmit to you the text of a communiqué which was issued relative to the application by the Republic of Korea to become a member of the United Nations:

"The Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines supports the aspiration of the Republic of Korea to seek membership of the United Nations during the course of this year as indicated in its memorandum S/22455 dated 5 April 1991.

"The Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines firmly believes that the admission of the Republic of Korea would not only be in conformity with the principle of universality, but that it would also assist in creating a better political environment for a peaceful solution to the Korean question."

I should be grateful if you would have the text of the letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
