Letter dated 6 June 1991 from the Permanent Representative of Nicaragua to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to transmit to you the communiqué issued by the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Nicaragua concerning the recent decision by the Governments of the Korean peninsula to enter the United Nations:

## Communiqué

In the light of the recent decision by the Governments of the Korean peninsula to enter the United Nations, the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Nicaragua informs the Nicaraguan people and the international community as follows:

Nicaragua has been an interested observer of the difficult process of reunification of the Korean peninsula, which constitutes the highest aspiration of that traditionally friendly people, whose leaders have in recent years shown a firm will to dialogue aimed at the attainment of that objective.

In this context, Nicaragua welcomes the recent decision of the two Governments to apply for full membership in the United Nations, in that this should be conducive to the process of reconciliation and reunification of Korea.

Likewise, the Government of Nicaragua makes known its decision to support the entry of the two Koreas into the Organization, in the conviction that this will promote international peace and security on the Korean peninsula.

Done at Managua City on 3 June 1991.
