## The Commission on Human Rights,

<u>Having in mind</u> General Assembly resolution 32/62 of 8 December 1977 by which the Commission was requested to draw up a draft convention on torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment, and resolution 1979/35 of 10 May 1979 by which the Economic and Social Council authorized an open-ended working group of the Commission on Human Rights to meet for a period of one week prior to the thirty-sixth session of the Commission to complete the work on a draft convention on torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment,

<u>Recalling</u> that such a draft convention has been discussed in a working group prior to and during the thirty-sixth session of the Commission but that it was not found possible to complete the work during that session,

Noting with satisfaction the progress made by the open-ended working group on the draft convention during the thirty-sixth session,

Desiring to make arrangements to expedite the work on the draft convention with a view to its early adoption,

1. <u>Recognizes</u> that it is advisable to continue the work on the draft convention in a working group which should meet before the thirty-seventh session of the Commission,

2. <u>Decides</u> to accord high priority to the consideration of this question at its thirty-seventh session,

3. <u>Recommends</u> that the Economic and Social Council should adopt the following resolution:
