Appointment of members of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

Report of the Fifth Committee (Part IV)

1. At its 72nd meeting, on 1 May 1986, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/40/101/Add.4) concerning a vacancy that has arisen on the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions as a result of the resignation of Mr. Igor V. Khalevinski.
2. Mr. Viktor Aleksandrovich Vislykh (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) was nominated by his Government to fill the vacancy in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for the unexpired portion of the term of office of Mr. Khalevinski, i.e., until 31 December 1987.
3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it should appoint Mr. Viktor Aleksandrovich Vislykh (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics) as a member of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a term of office beginning on 1 May 1986 and ending on 31 December 1987.
