LETTER DATED 15 JULY 1991 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that United States aircraft continue to violate Iraqi airspace, as follows:

I

- 1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 11/12 July 1991 amounted to 19 sorties flown by nine two-aircraft formations and one single aircraft at speeds of 600 to 720 kilometres per hour and at low and medium altitudes (4,000-5,000 metres).
- 2. Air activity centred over Dohuk, Arbil, the area north of Mosul and Amadiyah.

ΙI

- 1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 12/13 July 1991 amounted to 29 sorties flown by 12 two-aircraft formations and five single aircraft at speeds of 700 to 900 kilometres per hour and at altitudes ranging from 2,000 to 8,500 metres.
- 2. Air activity centred over Mosul, Dohuk, Arbil, Amadiyah, Rawanduz and Zakho, for the purpose of observation and provocation.

III

- 1. American air activity inside Iraqi airspace on 13/14 July 1991 amounted to 32 sorties flown by 15 two-aircraft formations and two single aircraft at speeds of 600 to 900 kilometres per hour and at low and medium altitudes.
- 2. Air activity was centred over Arbil, Mosul, Dohuk and Rawanduz, for the purpose of observation and provocation.
