NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At the 108th plenary meeting of its thirty-fourth session, on 18 December 1979, the General Assembly adopted resolution 34/192, entitled "Question of Southern Rhodesia".* In paragraph 10 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"Calls upon the Security Council to follow the situation closely until the people of Zimbabwe achieve genuine independence and majority rule".
