ELECTIONS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS

Election of seven members of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with paragraph 7 of the terms of reference of the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination (Economic and Social Council resolution 2008 (LX) of 14 May 1976, annex), the members of the Committee are nominated by the Economic and Social Council and elected by the General Assembly for a term of three years.
2. The membership of the Committee in 1986 is as follows (see General Assembly decision 40/312):

Argentina,*** Bangladesh,** Benin,*** Brazil,* Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic,** Cameroon * Egypt,* France,*** Germany, Federal Republic of,** India,* Indonesia,* Japan,* Liberia,* Netherlands,** Peru,*** Trinidad and Tobago,** Union of Soviet Socialist Republics,*** United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland,** United States of America,*** Yugoslavia** and Zambia.***

3. The General Assembly, at its forty-first session, will, therefore, be called upon to elect seven members, on the nomination of the Economic and Social Council, to fill the vacancies in the Committee for Programme and Co-ordination which will occur as a result of the expiration of the terms of office of Brazil, Cameroon, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Japan and Liberia. In accordance with paragraph 7 of the terms of reference of the Committee, the vacancies are to be filled as follows:

- (a) Three members from African States;
- (b) Three members from Asian States;
- (c) One member from Latin American States.

4. By its decision 1986/150 of 22 May 1986, the Economic and Social Council nominated the following Member States for election by the General Assembly at its forty-first session, for a term of three years, beginning on 1 January 1987:

- (a) African States (3 vacancies): Burkina Faso, Cameroon and Tunisia;
- (b) Asian States (3 vacancies): China, India, Indonesia, Japan and Pakistan;
- (c) Latin American States (1 vacancy): Brazil.
