Letter dated 23 July 1986 from the Permanent Representative of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic to the United

Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

At the thirteenth special session of the General Assembly, on the critical economic situation in Africa, the delegations of the People's Republic of Bulgaria, the Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic, the German Democratic Republic, the Hungarian People's Republic, the Mongolian People's Republic, the Polish People's Republic, the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics transmitted a joint statement which was issued as an official document of the session (see A/S-13/14).

In view of the direct relevance of the said document to item 29 of the provisional agenda of the forty-first session of the General Assembly entitled "Critical economic situation in Africa", I request that document A/S-13/14 be considered as an official document of the forty-first session of the General Assembly, under the aforementioned item of its provisional agenda.
