Letter dated 18 August 1986 from the Permanent Representative of
Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 30 July 1986 (A/41/497-S/18255), I have the honour to report to you a serious incident in violation of Pakistan territory from the Afghanistan side, which occurred on 13 August 1986. On that date between 0630 and 1015 hours (Pakistan standard time), the Afghan armed forces fired 79 rounds of artillery in the Shilman area of Khyber Agency. As a result of this firing, one civilian was killed and two civilians and two Afghan refugees were injured. One civilian pick-up van was also destroyed.

The Afghan Chargé d'affaires was summoned to the Foreign Office in Islamabad on 13 August 1986, and a strong protest was lodged with him over this unprovoked attack.
