Further to our letter dated 25 August 1986 (A/41/540-S/18294), I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Pakistan has rejected as baseless the allegation made by the Kabul authorities that on 28 August 1986, an aircraft of the Pakistan Air Force violated Afghan airspace in the Shahidan area of Paktya Province. Pakistan's rejection of the allegation was conveyed to the Afghan Chargé d'affaires on 2 September 1986.
