ALLOCATION OF AGENDA ITEMS TO THE FOURTH COMMITTEE

Letter dated 20 September 1986 from the President of the General
Assembly addressed to the Chairman of the Fourth Committee

I have the honour to inform you that at the 3rd plenary meeting of the forty-first session, held today, the General Assembly decided to allocate the following items to the Fourth Committee:

1. Information from Non-Self-Governing Territories transmitted under Article 73 e of the Charter of the United Nations (item 104):
 - (a) Report of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples;
 - (b) Report of the Secretary-General.
2. Activities of foreign economic and other interests which are impeding the implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples in Namibia and in all other Territories under colonial domination and efforts to eliminate colonialism, apartheid and racial discrimination in southern Africa: report of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples (item 105).
3. Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples by the specialized agencies and the international institutions associated with the United Nations (item 106):
 - (a) Report of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples;
 - (b) Report of the Secretary-General.

4. Report of the Economic and Social Council (chaps. I and VI (sect. D) and IX) (item 12).

7. Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples (item 19)

- (a) Report of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples;
- (b) Report of the Secretary-General.

[The General Assembly decided to refer to the Fourth Committee all the chapters of the report of the Special Committee (A/41/23) relating to specific Territories so that the Assembly might deal in plenary meeting with the question of the implementation of the Declaration as a whole.]

8. Question of the Falkland Islands (Malvinas): report of the Secretary-General (item 28).

[The General Assembly decided that the item would be considered directly in plenary meeting, on the understanding that bodies and individuals having an interest in the question would be heard in the Fourth Committee in conjunction with the consideration of the item in plenary meeting.]

- (a) Report of the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples;
- (b) Report of the United Nations Council for Namibia;
- (c) Report of the International Conference for the Immediate Independence of Namibia;
