On 13 January 1986, National Public Radio of the United States reported that, according to a study by Tel Aviv University, Israel was carrying out a brisk arms trade with South Africa.

2. Page 8, paragraph 23Replace the existing text with the following:

23. It has been reported that South African firms are using Israel to evade the economic sanctions. South African companies are investing in Israeli industries. There are more than 250 firms in Israel belonging to the South African-Israeli Chamber of Commerce, one of which is the steel plant of Iskoor, which is a joint venture of Koor Industries of Israel and the Iron and Steel Corporation of South Africa (ISCOR). Iskoor now produces about half of Israel's steel. 10/
