Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 23rd meeting, on 10 November 1986, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/41/32) on the programme budget implications of draft resolutions A/41/L.24, A/41/L.25 and Corr.1, A/41/L.26 and Corr.1, A/41/L.27, A/41/L.28 and A/41/L.29. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/41/SR.23).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 93 to 5, with 8 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolutions A/41/L.24, A/41/L.25 and Corr.1, A/41/L.26 and Corr.1, A/41/L.27, A/41/L.28 and A/41/L.29, an additional appropriation totalling \$737,200 would be required under the programme budget for the biennium 1986-1987, apportioned as follows:

An additional appropriation of \$1,500 would also be required under section 31 (Staff assessment), which would be offset by an increase of the same magnitude in the estimates of income under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment).

4. Conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$117,500. The actual additional appropriations that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.
