RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN DISARMAMENT AND DEVELOPMENT

Draft decision proposed by the Chairman

International Conference on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development

The First Committee, on the recommendation of the Preparatory Committee for the International Conference on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development 1/ and in conformity with General Assembly decision 40/473 of 20 June 1986, recommends that the General Assembly decide to hold the International Conference on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development at United Nations Headquarters in New York from 24 August to 11 September 1987, to convene the Preparatory Committee for one more session from 21 April to 1 May 1987 and to request the Member States and the Secretary-General of the Conference, based on the information in the report of the Preparatory Committee 2/ concerning the results so far achieved in the substantial and organizational preparation for the Conference, to continue and intensify their participation in the final stage of the preparatory process, especially in making available their views and proposals on substantive issues, in order to ensure the best possible success of the Conference.
