Note by the Secretary-General

The Secretary-General wishes to inform the Security Council that he has decided to appoint Mr. Hugo Gobbi as his Special Representative in Cyprus. Mr. Gobbi, who served as alternate representative of Argentina on the Security Council from 1966 to 1967, was also member of the Argentine delegation to the twenty-first, twenty-second and twenty-third sessions of the General Assembly. Mr. Gobbi served in the Foreign Ministry of his country until 1976. Since then he has been in private legal practice. Mr. Gobbi will take up his new post early in May 1980.

On this occasion, I should like to express my sincere thanks and appreciation to Mr. Reynaldo Galindo-Pohl, who is relinquishing the post of Special Representative, at his request and as planned, after two years of service. Since May 1978, Mr. Galindo-Pohl has made a distinguished contribution to the cause of peace in Cyprus.
