During the week ending 22 November 1986, the Security Council took action on the following item:

Letter dated 13 November 1986 from the Permanent Representative of Chad to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

In a letter dated 13 November 1986 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/18456), the representative of Chad requested that an urgent meeting of the Security Council be convened to consider the serious situation prevailing in his country.

The Security Council met to consider the item at its 2721st meeting, held on 18 November 1986, on the basis of the above request.

In the course of the meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Chad, Egypt, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya and Zaire, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
