The General Assembly,

Mindful of the importance of confidence-building for the peaceful settlement of existing international problems and for the improvement and promotion of international relations based on co-operation and solidarity,

Stressing the potential of specific confidence-building measures to create favourable conditions for progress in the field of arms control and disarmament,

Bearing in mind that confidence-building measures may serve the objective of facilitating verification of arms limitation and disarmament agreements,

Recalling that the ultimate goal of confidence-building measures is to strengthen international peace and security and to contribute to the prevention of war,

Welcoming the draft text of guidelines for confidence-building measures contained in the report of the United Nations Disarmament Commission as particularly appropriate to serve this important objective,

Expecting that new developments in the field of disarmament and growing positive and concrete experience with confidence-building measures will facilitate further elaboration of the text,
