Letter dated 20 November 1986 from the Permanent Representative of  
Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 12 November 1986 (A/41/831-S/18459), I have the honour to report to you the following serious incidents in violation of Pakistan territory and airspace from the Afghanistan side, which occurred on 15, 17 and 18 November 1986:

On 15 November 1986, at 1600 hours (Pakistan standard time), the Afghan armed forces fired three tank rounds which landed in the area of Spin Suka approximately 8 kilometres north of Landi Kotal, as a result of which one Sepoy of the Khyber Rifles was killed.

On 17 November 1986, at 1015 hours (Pakistan standard time), four Afghan aircraft penetrated Pakistan's airspace by 4 kilometres in the Saidgi area of North Waziristan Agency. The aircraft dropped two bombs as a result of which 3 civilians were injured.

On 18 November 1986, between 0850 hours and 2200 hours (Pakistan standard time), the Afghan armed forces fired several rounds of artillery in the Shilman area of Khyber Agency, as a result of which one Sepoy of the Khyber Rifles was killed and five were injured.

The Afghan Chargé d'affaires was summoned to the Foreign Office at Islamabad on 20 November 1986, and a strong protest was lodged with him over these unprovoked attacks.

I request you to have this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 26, 68, 69, 124, 129 and 133, and of the Security Council.
