Appointment of members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Soeprapto HERIJANTO (Indonesia)

1. At its 31st meeting, on 21 November 1986, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/41/105) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal that will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of two of its members on 31 December 1986.
2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/41/44) containing the names of two persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment or reappointment to the Administrative Tribunal.
3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend the appointment to the United Nations Administrative Tribunal, for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1987, of Mr. Jerome Ackerman (United States of America) and Mr. Arnold Wilfred Geoffrey Kean (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland).

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should appoint the following persons as members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 1987:
